Announces 2020-2021 Internship, Scholarship and Program Grant Opportunities

- ▲ **The Stephanie Tubbs Jones Summer Internship (STJ)** is awarded to an undergraduate student currently enrolled in a college or university with a demonstrated interest in public service, governance, and policy-making process. Students will gain experience in the office of a member of the United States Congress, receive a stipend and be provided room and board at a local university.
- ▲ **The Eula Dean Roby Scholarship** is awarded to high school graduating seniors or students currently enrolled in a college or university. All applicants for the Roby Scholarship MUST major in education.
- ▲ **The Oleta L. Crain Scholarship** is awarded to female students graduating from high school and will enroll at a Historically Black College and University (HBCU). The applicants must reside in one of the following states: Colorado, Oklahoma, or Missouri.
- ▲ **The Mentoring Keys Scholarship** is a new educational opportunity generously funded by the KeyBank Foundation.

The scholarship award is open to African American students pursuing a bachelor's degree in business related disciplines at a Historically Black College and University (HBCU). The scholarship award of \$5,000 will be made over a two-year period, beginning with the junior year of study through the senior year; applicants must apply during their sophomore year. A major component of the Mentoring Keys Scholarship will include a Mentoring Keys Advisory Panel to assist the scholarship awardee in achieving academic success and personal development.

- ▲ **Community Empowerment Grantmaking** encourages collegiate and alumnae chapters to apply for a grant through the 2020-21 Community Empowerment Grantmaking Program applications are requested this year for grants focusing on gun violence prevention, voter registration and education, or the U.S. Census. Grant awards range from \$500 to \$1,500 based on rating score of application.

The application period for all internship, scholarship and grant opportunities is
November 11, 2019 until the deadline date of **March 23, 2020**.
